Introduction

The Organisation of Eastern and Southern Africa (OESAI) was formed in 1973 as a result of the initiative of eight insurance companies in the East and Southern Africa region. The eight founding insurance companies include: Kenya National Reinsurance Corporation, Kenya; Zambia State Insurance Corporation Ltd, Zambia; Kenya National Insurance Company, Kenya; Jubilee Insurance Company Ltd; National Insurance Corporation of Tanzania Ltd, Tanzania; National Insurance Corporation of Uganda Ltd, Uganda; Pan African Insurance Company Ltd, Kenya; Reinsurance Company of Mauritius, Mauritius. From the founding membership of eight companies form five countries, OESAI has grown and currently has 135 member companies from countries in and out of the region.
